ORDINANCE NO.2023-05

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CITY OF LAFOLLETTE CODE, TITLE 9, "BUSINESS, PEDDLERS, SOLICITERS, ETC", AS SET FORTH IN TITLE 9

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMAN OF THE CITY OF LAFOLLETTE, TENNESSEE, as follows:

That Title 9 "Business, Peddlers, Solicitors, etc", shall be amended by adding a new section, 9-901, "Events on City owned/maintained property, which shall read as follows:

- 9-901. Any event or gathering organized and publicized that shall be held on city own and/or maintained property shall first obtain a permit for said anticipated event. The organizer of the proposed event shall disclose the date, purpose and location of the event. Upon application for permit, the proposed application shall be placed on the agenda for a regularly scheduled council meeting and same shall be approved or denied by council by roll call vote. There shall be no cost for said permit.
- A. <u>Conflict with Other Ordinances</u>. In case of conflict between this ordinance or any part thereof, and the whole or part of any existing or future ordinance of the City of LaFollette, the most restrictive shall in all cases apply.
- B. <u>Validity</u>. If any section, clause, provision, or portion of this Ordinance shall be held to be in doubt or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such holding shall not affect any other section, clause, provision, or portion of this Ordinance which is not of itself invalid or unconstitutional.
- C. <u>Remaining Sections</u>. This amendment only applies to Section V(A) of said policy and all remaining terms and sections not specifically amended herein shall remain in full force and effect.
- **D.** <u>Effective Date.</u> This ordinance shall become effective upon passage and publication, the public welfare requiring it.
